



# Year 2 Curriculum



In Maths we cover a range of topics such as, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, measurement, shape and reasoning. We use different strategies to ensure children are equipped for KS2.



In Literacy we use the power of reading scheme. We will cover a range of books, including, The Sweetest Song, The Lonely Beast, Traction Man, The Dark, One day in Savannah and Lila and the Secret of the Rain.

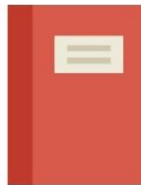


In Science, Year 2 will be learning about everyday materials, working scientifically, living things and their habitats, animals including humans and plants.



In History, Year 2 will be learning about Local History – Slough through the ages and Significant event: The Great Fire of London

In Geography, Year 2 are learning about their locality. They will also be learning about rivers and oceans and a comparison of Kenya and Slough



Reading is taught every day and children are introduced to different genres, both fiction and non-fiction. Please read with children every day and sign their reading record. Children are expected to take at least two to three quizzes per week and change their reading books two to three times a week.



The School have adopted a new scheme of work called Kapow. Children will still learn about E-safety during computing lessons.

In RE, Year 2 will be learning about Christianity and Islam.

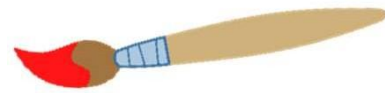
Booklets are given out every Wednesday for maths, SPAG and comprehension. They are due in the following Wednesday.



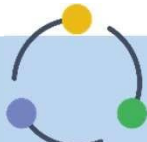
### PE
