

Year 3 Curriculum



We will be covering a range of maths topics this term, including addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, shape, fractions, measurement and real life problem solving. Knowledge of times tables and division facts will be practised weekly using times table rockstars.



In Literacy, children will read a range of texts to broaden their creative imagination. We will be looking at different types of writing including character descriptions, balanced arguments, diary entries, as well as some role play. Children will be drafting, editing and writing tasks every half term.



In Science, year 3 will be learning about animals including humans, light, rocks, plants, forces and magnets and carrying out a range of experiments.



In History, year 3 will be learning about the stone age to iron age, the earliest civilisations and early Islamic civilisations.



Reading is taught every day and children are introduced to different genres, both fiction and non-fiction to increase their love of reading and enhance their comprehension skills. Please read with children every day and sign their reading record. Children are expected to take at least two quizzes per week and change their reading books twice a week depending on the size of their book.



In computing this year will be learning programming, networks, internet safety, creating media and data handling

Trip to a local Gurdwara to link with their RE lessons.










