



Year 5 Curriculum







In Maths this year, each term will begin with place value activities and then lead into addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also develop skills related to shape, coordinates, data handling and measures. Knowledge of times tables will be practiced weekly.

In Literacy, this year, we will be studying several texts as listed in the reading section. We will be looking at different types of writing including predictions, diary entries, setting descriptions, play scripts, as well as some role play. The Year 5 Science curriculum topics will include: Forces, Earth and Space, Properties and changes of materials, Animals including humans and Living things and their habitats.







In History, the children will learn about: Windsor Castle from 1066 to present day, Elizabethan Times and The Victorians. Geography topics include: Mountains, Volcanoes and Earthquakes and From the Rainforest to Reindeer

Reading lessons take place everyday. based on Power of Reading texts: There is a boy in the girls' bathroom, A Star Outside My Window, The Highwayman, Skellig, Shackleton's Journey and Street Child. Children are encouraged to read a range of books both in school and at home daily.

The computing curriculum includes the following:, learning about E -Safety, Computing systems and networks, Programming, Data Handling, Creating media and Inventing a product.

During RE lessons, the children will explore: how Sikhs show commitment, truth in the Christmas story, the idea of Brahman being in everything and everywhere, how Hindus show commitment and how Christians show commitment.

Children are given Maths, Reading Comprehension and SPAG homework each week. All homework is due in on the following Wednesday. Spellings are given every week and tested the following week. R- Time session (which focus on the development of social skills) will be carried out twice weekly.

In language lessons, children will learn new words and phrases, and will also continue to focus on the writing and the speaking of the language.

In Art this year, children will be: sketching artefacts, using pastels and watercolours to create artwork based on that of Hundertwasser, and completing a unit of work based on Seurat's Pointillism.

During DT lessons, we will be designing and constructing bridges and we will be completing a mini-enterprise project.



In PE, the Year 5 children are learning advanced skills in a number of different sports including: football, athletics, netball and gymnastics. These sports allow children to push themselves further in events and competitions that come up throughout the year.
