





In Maths we cover a range of topics such as, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division. fractions, measurement, shape and reasoning. We use different strategies to ensure children are equipped to take their KS1 SATS.



In Literacy we use the power of reading scheme. We will cover a range of books, including, The Sweetest Song, The Lonely Beast, Traction Man, The Dark, One day in Savannah and Lila and the Secret of the Rain.



In Science, Year 2 will be learning about everyday materials, working scientifically, living things and their habitats, animals including humans and plants.



In History, Year 2 will be learning about The Great Fire of London and the Egyptians. In Geography, Year 2 will be comparing Kenya and Slough, learning about rivers and oceans and using atlases.



Reading is taught every day and children are introduced to different genres, both fiction and non-fiction. Please read with children every day and sign their reading record. Children are expected to take at least two to three quizzes per week and change their reading books two to three times a week



The School have adopted a new scheme of work called Icompute. Children will still learn about Esafety during ICT lessons.
